7. Read a book published in 2020.
8. Travel back in time – read a western.
9. Read a *NY Times* bestseller.
10. Read a DIY book (gardening, cooking, crafting, woodworking, etc.).
11. Read an author "new" to you.
12. Read a book based on a true story.
13. Read a book with a travel destination.
14. Read a mystery/suspense book.
15. Read about the history of Hutchinson.
16. Book detour = librarian's choice!
