

# Hutchinson Public Library's "Library Express"

## Current Browsing Hours:

**Monday-Thursday 10 a.m.-7 p.m.; Friday 10 a.m.-3 p.m.; Saturday 10 a.m.-1 p.m.**

### **How this works...**

- 15-minute browsing sessions—no appointments needed.
- Limited building capacity available during Library Express hours.
- Age 13 or older may stop in for a browsing session. Under age 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
- We ask that you wear a mask, limit your visit to 15 minutes, and keep a distance of 6 feet between you and other patrons and staff.
- If you are feeling ill, please do **not** come to the library.

### **When you arrive...**

- Return all materials to the outdoor dropbox—indoor book return is closed.
- Please stop at the hand sanitizing station to check in.

### **While you are in the library...**

- You may browse the collection, check out items, pick up your holds, ask reference questions, apply for a library card or ask staff to scan/fax materials.  
*All library tasks must be completed within your 15-minute session.*
- Please have your library card with you to check out.
- Library staff will frequently disinfect the service desk and door handles.
- Meeting rooms are **not** available and there are no sitting areas at this time.
- Computer appointments need to be scheduled.
